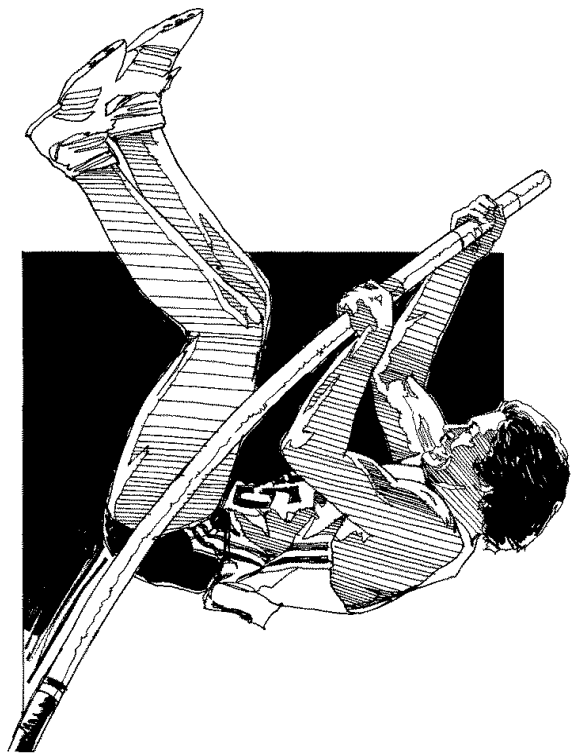

YOUTH AGE DIVISIONS – Youth age divisions provide youth athletes the opportunity to compete with other athletes of similar ability in two-year age divisions. Age divisions for the 2011 competition season are as follows:

Sub-Bantam* 2003+, Bantam 2001-2002, Midget 1999-2000, Youth 1997-1998, Intermediate 1995-1996, Young Men/Women** 1993-1994

* Sub-bantam athletes must be 7 years old prior to December 31, 2011 to participate in the National Junior Olympic Track & Field Championships.

** Athletes who are still 18 through the final day of the USATF National Junior Olympic Track & Field Championships are eligible to compete in the Young Men's and Young Women's divisions through that meet. This extended eligibility does not apply to cross country events.
